Memorandum To: Risk Class 2 facilities lacking required training

RE: Required food safety training

According to our records, your establishment has failed to obtain the required training in food safety. This requirement came into effect on January 2, 2011. At least one person in charge must attend a minimum of 6 hour class in food safety and obtain a certificate. If one person in charge at your establishment has the required training, please provide a copy of the certificate to this office within 10 days of this notice.

If no one has the training, you are **directed to comply** with this requirement within 60 days of this letter or prior to opening for the season (seasonal facilities only). To assist you in this requirement, we are offering one more food safety class in English on January 24 and 25, 2011 from 1 to 4 pm. We also have a Food safety class in Spanish on February 28 and March 1, 2011. You must attend both days to complete the course. For seasonal facilities, we will be offering additional classes in March (to be announced in the February Newsletter).

If you are sending someone to the class in January or February, please complete the enclosed application and return by January 18, 2011. If you have already paid for the class, but missed the date, please send in the application without the fee.
